

A National Commitment

Head Start is the national commitment to give every child, regardless of circumstances at birth, an opportunity to succeed in school and in life. In the 50 years since its inception, Head Start has improved the lives of more than thirty-two million children and their families. Head Start alumni - or "Head Start babies," as they often call themselves - are in all walks of the nation's life.

Educators, doctors, lawyers, military personnel, artists, engineers, religious and civic leaders, and scientists - from across the country - remember Head Start as the place where, at an early age, they acquired a life-long love of learning.

In addition to life and school preparedness, Head Start is also the nation's laboratory for early learning innovation. Head Start offers a unique whole child/whole family program design coupled with a delivery system that includes local programs, national standards, monitoring, professional development, and family engagement. This has been the basis for many subsequent statewide and community initiatives.
