Parent/Child Incorporated's version of the State of the Union, called the **Annual Report to the Public, was a huge success!** Each Head Start agency is required to make available to the public a report published at least once in each fiscal year that discloses the following information from the recently concluded fiscal year which includes (A)The total amount of public and private funds received and the amount from each source; (B) An explanation of budgetary expenditures and the proposed budget for the fiscal year; (C) The total number of children and families served, the average monthly enrollment, and the percentage of eligible children served; (D) The results of the most recent review by the Secretary and the financial audit; (E)The percentage of enrolled

children that received medical and dental exams; (F) Information about parent involvement activities; (G)The agency's efforts to prepare children for kindergarten.

This information will of course benefit these individuals but will also be brought back to PCI to make our staff better equipped for teaching and learning. Congratulations, Ladies!


Early Payroll
